

HARTFORD RECEIVES NEARLY \$2 MILLION IN RURAL DEVELOPMENT FUNDS FOR SEWER IMPROVEMENTS

The City of Hartford has secured special Recovery Act financing for wastewater improvements through the U.S. Department of Agriculture Rural Development (USDA RD). The funding includes a \$600,000 grant, in addition to a \$1.34 million low-interest loan (2.75% over 40 years). Hartford will use this money to replace aging sewer lines throughout the city, to better serve their residents.
